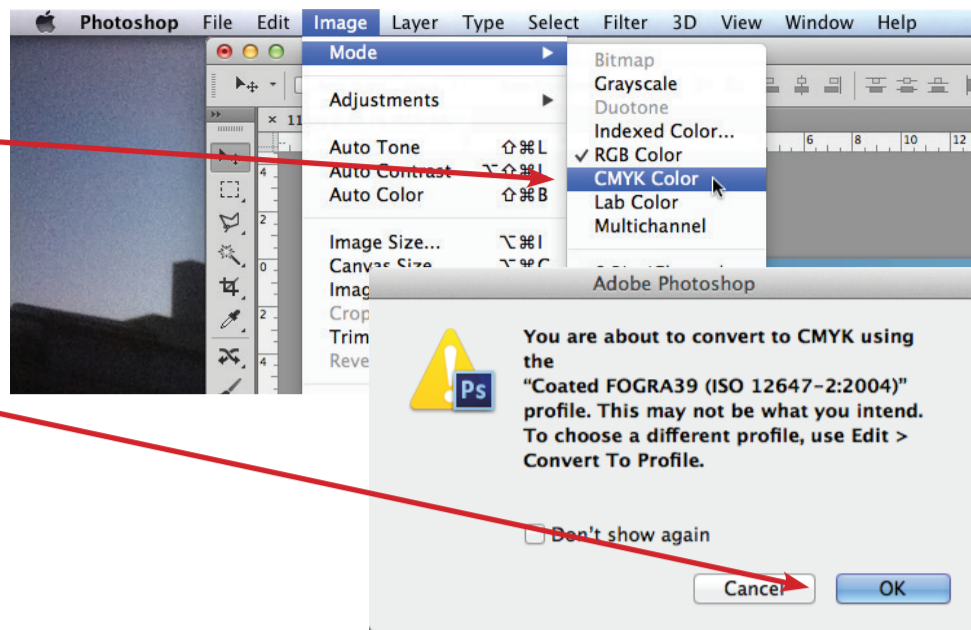


First, set your image to CMYK mode

- Choose *Image > Mode > CMYK*

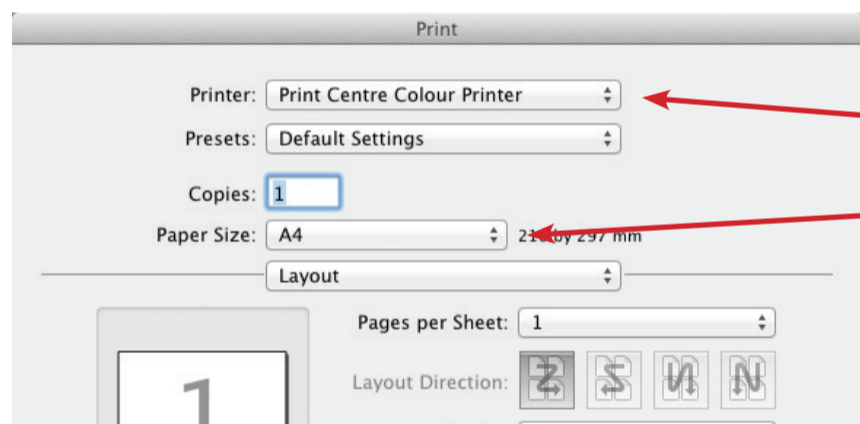
This will open a warning informing you of the Colour Profile that you will be using

- In the warning dialog box click *OK*



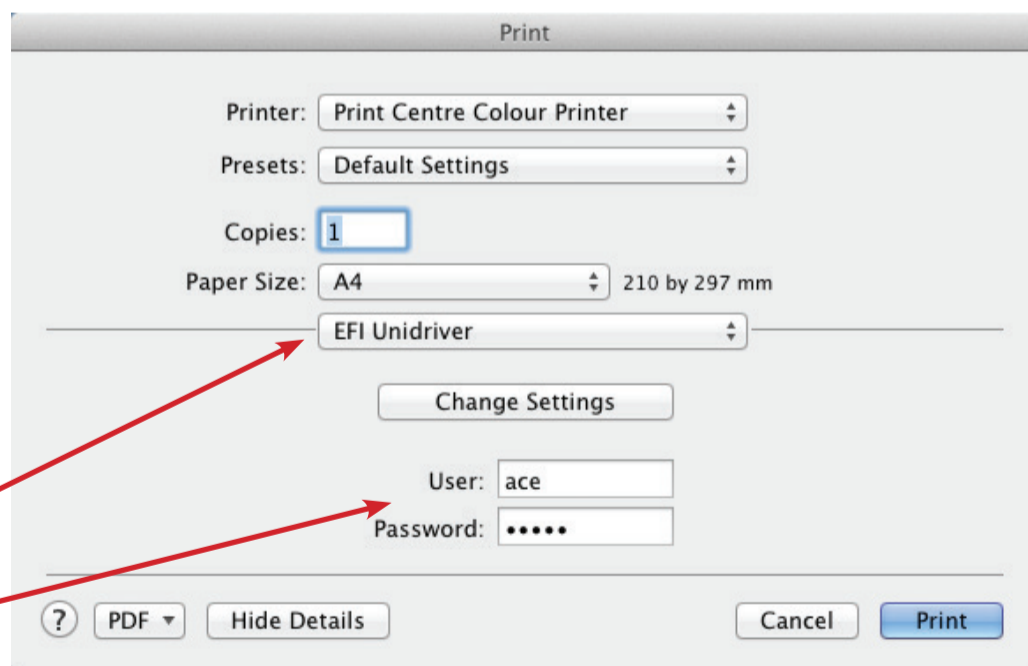
Choose *File > Print*

- In *Printer Setup > Printer* select *Print Centre Colour Printer*
- Set *Portrait* or *Landscape* orientation
- In *Color Management* choose *Color Handling > Printer Manages Colors*
- Click *Print*
This will open the *Print* dialog box



In the print dialogue box ...

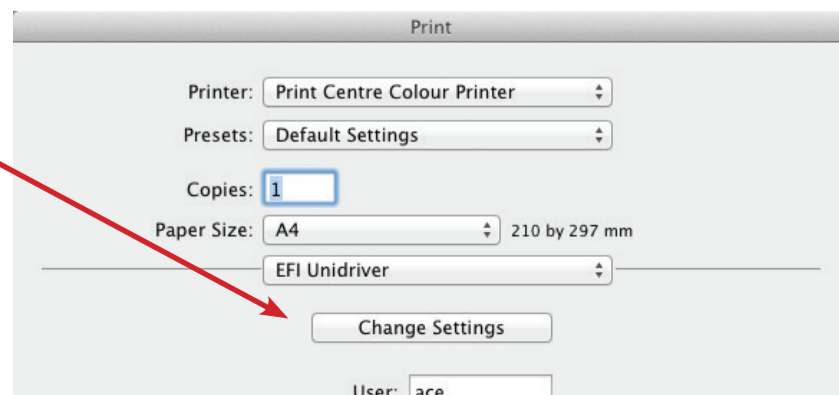
- Check the correct Printer is chosen ... in this case the *Print Centre Colour Printer*.
- Set the correct paper size



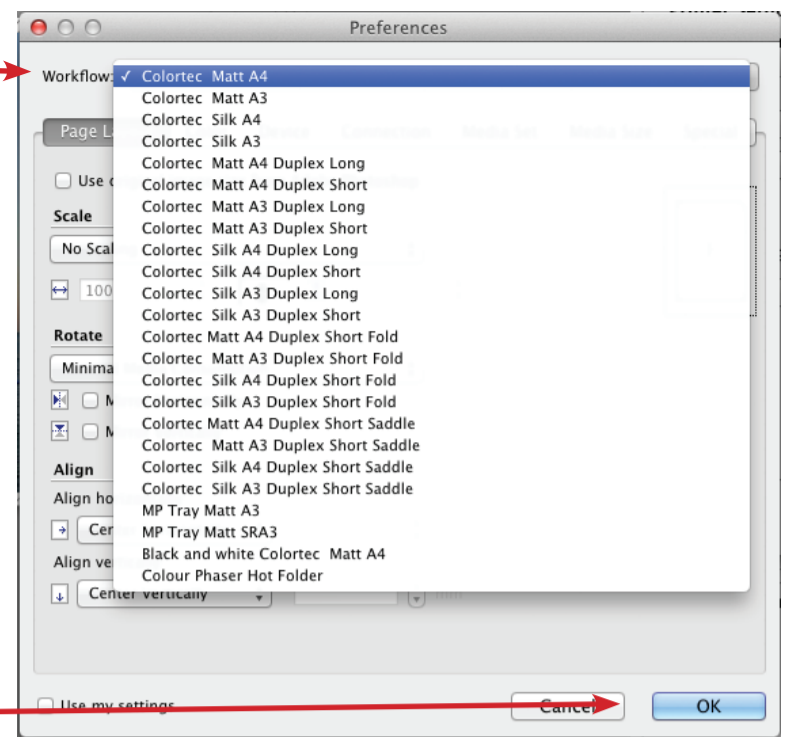
From the drop down menu ...

- Select *EFI Unidriver Settings*
- if different, set the username to *ace* and enter the usual student password (this should already be set by default)

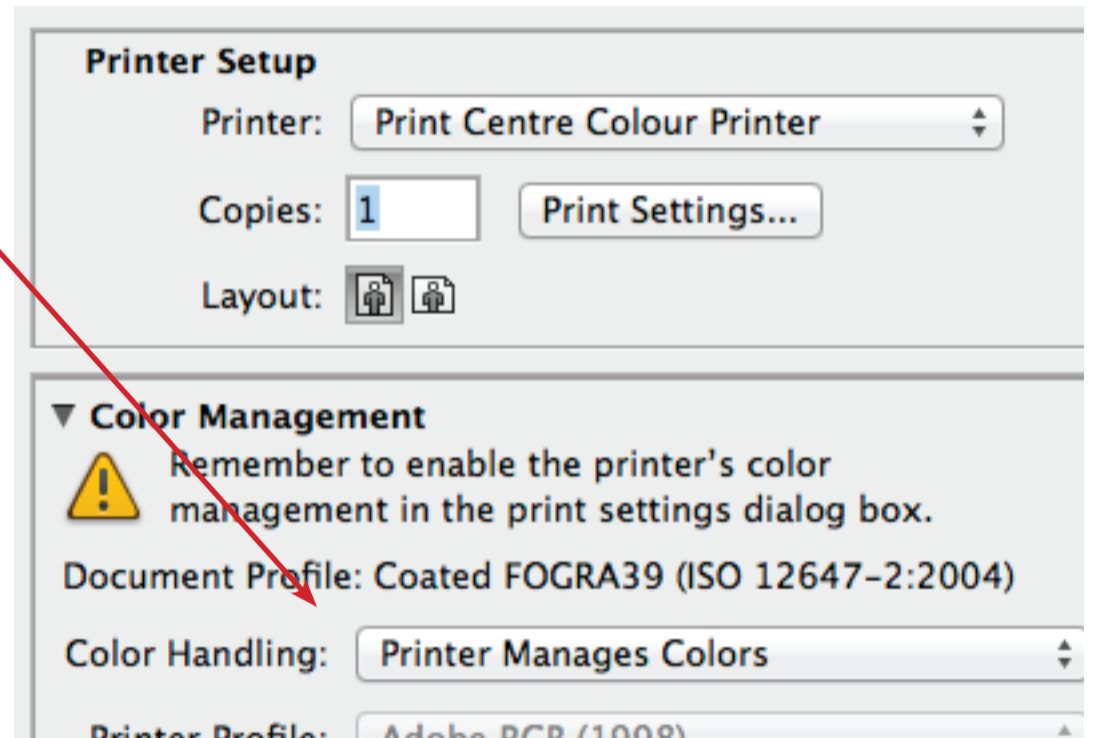
- Click the *Change Settings* buttons
This will open the *workflow* window



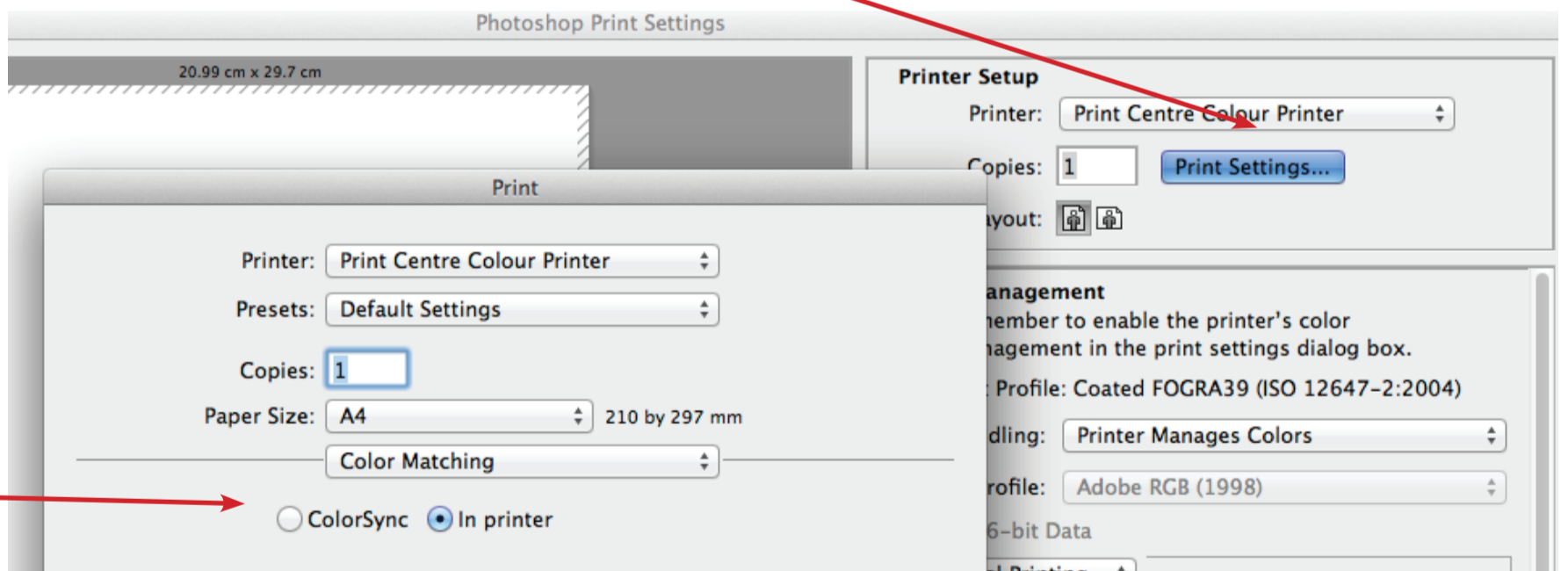
- from the *Workflow* drop down menu choose the correct paper type, size and, if required, duplex option (if you have any problems, or would like to see the different paper stocks on offer, see Ben or Arthur in the Print Centre [room 0G5])
- Click *OK*
This will return you to the main print dialog box



- Under the Color Management section of the main dialog box, make sure that the *Color Handling* is set to the *Printer Manages Colors* option from the drop down menu



- Click on *Print Settings*
This opens the print dialog box
- Choose the *Color Matching* option from the drop down menu



Make sure that you set both colour handling settings correctly to ensure a more reliable print result.

In the main Print dialog box ...

- Choose *Print* and remembering the name of your print job, go to collect your print from the wide format print room in the Print Centre at the appropriate time.
